What to Bring


- Mosquito repellent.

	River Ecology and River Float	Learn about the fresh water ecosystem of the river Kwae Yai and observe the abundant wildlife. The float requires getting in the water with life vests. A safety raft is also present for those not comfortable floating.
	Jungle Ecology and Trekking	Visitors will do a 30 minute trek through fairly easy terrain, exploring the path wild elephants use to drink from the river. learning about how wildlife interact and rely on the preservation of corridors.
	OurLand Introduction	Explore the 3 core pillars of OurLand (Conservation, Education, and Sustainability) and the different initiatives that allow us to operate completely off-grid.
	Human Elephant Conflict	Learn about the systemic and interlinking challenges facing local communities on the front lines of HEC. Discover emerging solutions and integrate systems thinking into your own lives.
	Mud Bricks and Mud Architecture	Discover the ancient architectural technique of mud construction. Mud homes have been made from the beginning of civilization and remains one the most sustainable way to make a house! Visitors will participate in mixing mud and straw and molding their

own bricks.

Low Carbon, Wildlife Friendly, Ethical Ecotourism

OurLand Thailand is an organization working to increase wild spaces and ensure human-wildlife-coexistence. We fund our activities through engaged ecotourism and nature education. Our ecovillage, where you will be staying is completely off grid and powered by solar. We harvest rainwater, cook with biogas, and build using traditional mud architecture and sustainably harvested bamboo. We make sure to involve and support the local community in all our endeavors.
